



The Commission in its meeting held on 23.12.2024 has approved the recommendation of the Standing Committee on Autonomous Colleges to confer the autonomous status to GRY Institute of Pharmacy, Gram Borawan, Tehsil Kasrawad, Distt. Khargone MP- 451228, affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi Prodyogiki Vishwavidhyalaya, Bhopal for a period of 05 years from the academic year 2025-2026 to 2029-2030 as per clause 7.4 of the UGC (Conferment of Autonomous Status Upon Colleges and Measures for Maintenance of Standards in Autonomous Colleges) Regulations, 2023.

The University, is therefore, requested to issue necessary notification within 30 days regarding the grant of autonomous status to the College as per above mentioned UGC Regulations.

The college shall apply to University Grants Commission for extension of autonomous status at least three months before the completion of the period of autonomy.
