

Policy Document

GREEN CAMPUS INITIATIVES

GRY Institute of Pharmacy is dedicated to raising environmental awareness among its students and the general public. For long-term development, environmentally friendly methods are promoted, and the institution's natural setting encourages a stress-free learning atmosphere on campus. The institution's green practices are described further down. Rainwater harvesting and recycling are two methods for resolving and managing future water scarcity issues. Our maintenance team inspects tap leaks on a regular basis and responds quickly to any repair needs to avoid a loss of drinkable water. In hostels, water consumption is reduced by facilitating the use of washing machines.

Water Resources and Rain Water Harvesting

Because the college is located in a hot climatic zone, it understands the necessity of water conservation and efficient use. Water resources are both maintained and generated at the college. To address the institution's general demands, the college has a bore well. The institution promotes RO water recycling and rainwater gathering. Water from the roof tops, as well as rainwater, is collected and sent through a well-connected pipework system. This design aids in the collection of water, which is subsequently gathered in pits built specifically for this purpose. The rainwater collected in the pits is used to keep the campus's green cover in good shape. During the hot summer months, when water is scarcer, the boreholes in the area become more active.


Energy Consumption

Restricted Entry of Automobiles

No vehicles are permitted on campus, resulting in a pollution-free environment. The automobiles are parked just outside the campus's main gate. Students in the area are encouraged to ride their bicycles to college. PUC certification is required for all college buses and vehicles used by college members, and it is renewed on a regular basis.

Pedestrian-friendly Path

The pathways on campus are well-kept, and pedestrians can safely walk about the college because car entry is prohibited. Security guards stationed at the two gates keep an eye on cars entering and exiting the property. Pedestrian-friendly paths are clearly identified with appropriate signage. Many of the non-teaching staff and a few students from the area walk to college every day.


Ban on use of Plastic

The campus is a plastic-free zone, with single-use plastics strictly prohibited on campus. The plastic waste is collected in special bins. Students take part in awareness events both on and off campus. Students are periodically informed about the dangers of using plastic by holding seminars in order to establish a Plastic Free Zone.

Land scaping with Trees and Plants:

The quantity of trees and plants on campus produces an environmentally friendly environment and has a good impact on the stakeholders, who engage with the institution through various plantation activities. The institute employs a full-time gardener who is responsible for maintaining and monitoring the institute's natural flora and medicinal garden. The majority of the college's corridors are lined with potted plants. On campus, there is a distinct herbal garden.

Efforts for Carbon neutrality

The institute features a medicinal garden with approximately 100 plants. It was founded with the intention of cultivating and maintaining medicinal plants for educational and research purposes. The main goal is to keep a conservatory of the most frequent and significant medicinal and aromatic plant species that are used in everyday basic health care. The college prohibits the use of plastic bags, which aids in the achievement of Carbon Neutrality. Students and professors participate in Green Campus Initiatives through the campus NSS Unit's Swachh Bharat initiatives.

Paperless work

The college relies on technology to keep the campus paperless. The bulk sms service, emails, and other social media are used for most of the official communication, such as notices for various meetings of staff and students, holiday notices, programme communication, greetings on various occasions, and so on. Emails, sms, and social media are chosen for sending invitations, participation news, and viewpoints (for conferences, interviews, campus interviews, seminars, workshops, and so on). Printouts are not preferred until paper is required, and the majority of the work is done using soft copies on computers. The college's staff and students made significant contributions to the planting of trees as part of the college's NSS Unit's Swachh Bharat efforts.

Waste Management

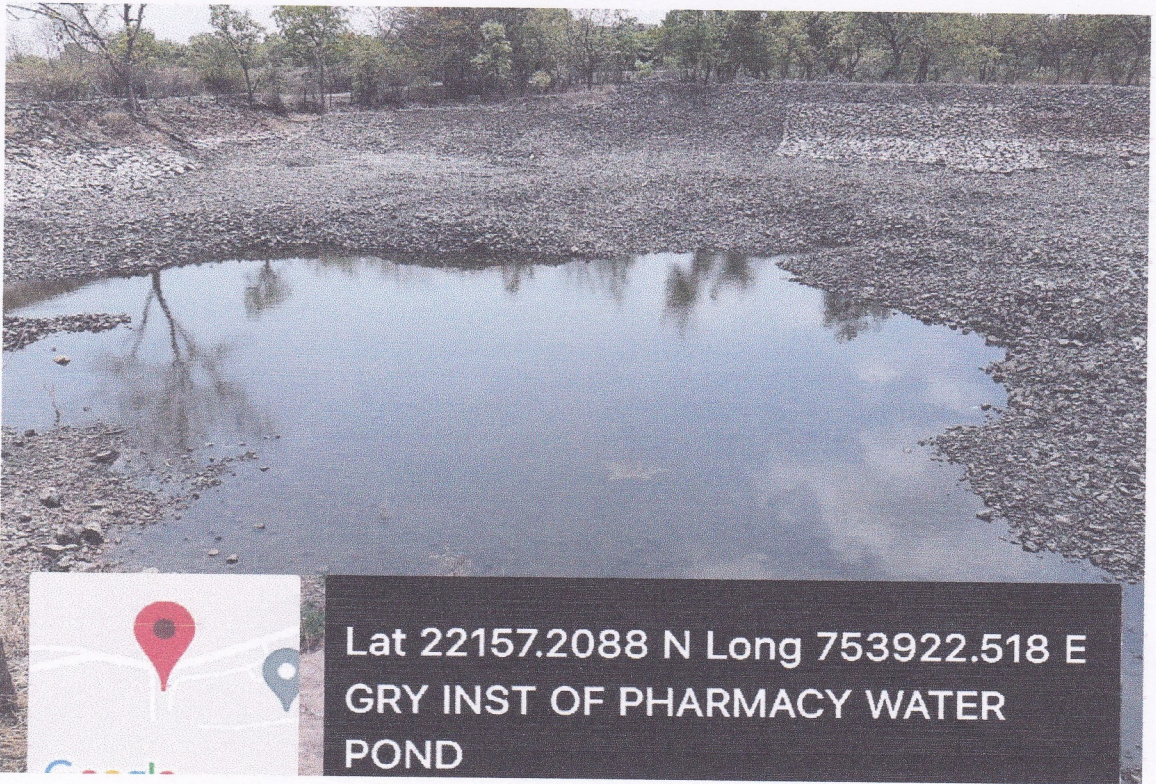

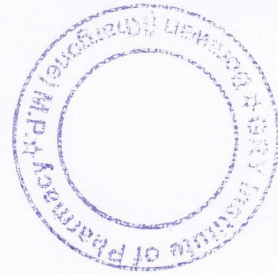


CIRCULAR
