***Initiative 1:***

**SEMINAR/CONFERENCE/WORKSHOP:** A national conference on Educational Innovation Tools And Their Implementation For Quality Teaching was organized on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2023. The conference is funded by NAAC and GRYIP Borawan. Around 200 participants participated in the conference and 35 paper was presented.

***Initiative 2:***

AISHE All India Survey of Higher Education, (AISHE) - was submitted for the session.

***Initiative 3:***

Students, teacher, alumni and employers feedback on curriculum is conducted for the session. The students and teachers' feedback is taken offline while the employers and alumni feedback is taken in hybrid mode. Teacher's feedback format is modified by the IQAC. On the basis of feedback collected, analysis was done and accordingly action taken report was prepared.

***Initiative 4:***

A **learning management system (LMS)** is a software application is upgraded as per the requirements of faculty and students. Some new features are added in the LMS like faculty feedback and analysis.

***Initiative 5:***

Extra classes, remedial classes were conducted for the students. Apart from this extra and remedial classes also arranged for weak/slow learner students. Additional English classes arranged for weak students in English communication. Classes for faculty for effective communication was organized in regular manner.

***Initiative 6:***

The extension activity of NSS and NCC health survey, blood donation camps and swacchata abhiyan programs, aids awareness program etc. were organized in the session 2022-23.
